

Notice on Preventing Respiratory Diseases in Wuhan City, China

The cluster of severe pneumonia cases is recently reported in Wuhan, Hubei Province, the People's Republic of China. As a precautionary measure, entrants from China are advised to follow the instructions below. This will help early detection of cases and prevention of spread of diseases.

| What are major symptoms?

Fever (37.5°C or above), respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, sputum, difficulty in breathing), pneumonia.

| Who should pay attention?

History of visiting the Huanan seafood market in Wuhan City within 14 days.

| How can I protect myself?

Wear a mask; cover your mouth with upper sleeve when coughing; and wash your hands.

| What should I do after returning to Korea?

If you develop any respiratory symptoms within 14 days after returning to Korea, please call the KCDC Call Center at 1339.

※ In accordance with paragraph 5 of Article 76-2 of the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act, the records of individuals' overseas travel shall be delivered to medical institutions to provide information for medical diagnosis and treatment. No relevant information shall be used for any other purpose than infectious disease prevention, and such relevant information shall be deleted immediately after an incubation period of 14 days.
